Valuing Volunteers Policy

Derrynoose GAC recognises the valuable input of volunteers to our club. We are committed to supporting our volunteers in their role. The following procedures for recruitment of volunteers will place them in a situation to which they are suited, to assist in the protection of children and volunteers alike.

The club will:

- Provide training for volunteers in their role by urging them to attend Ulster Club Maith Officer Training Programme
- Make vacancies within the club openly available to interested and qualified applicants
- There may be need for new club coaches who have substantial access to children regardless of whether they are paid or not, to have their background checked
- All recommendations for member appointment should be ratified by the club's Executive Committee. The decision to appoint team managers is taken in conjunction with the relevant sub-committee, executive committee and Coaching Officer
- Once recruited into the club, all volunteers should be adequately managed and supported
- Any statutory guidelines should be adhered to
